## Guitar Tricks 76: 3-String Sweeps

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Measures 21 and 22 of the 3-String Sweeps exercise. Measure 21 contains a three-string sweep across frets 10, 9, 11, 9, 10, 9, 11, 9, 10, 9, 11, 9. Measure 22 contains a three-string sweep across frets 10, 9, 11, 9, 10, 9, 11, 9.

Measures 23 and 24 of the 3-String Sweeps exercise. Measure 23 contains a three-string sweep across frets 10, 9, 11, 9, 10, 9, 11, 9, 10, 9, 11, 9. Measure 24 contains a three-string sweep across frets 10, 9, 11, 9, 10, 9, 11, 9, followed by a rest.

### Lesson of the Week: Three-String Sweep Picking

Measures 25 through 29 of the Lesson of the Week. Measure 25 is Dm (frets 14, 15, 13). Measure 26 is C (frets 12, 13, 12). Measure 27 is Bb (frets 10, 11, 10). Measure 28 is Asus4 (frets 17, 12, 15, 14). Measure 29 is A (frets 17, 12, 14, 14).

Measures 30 through 35 of the Lesson of the Week. Measure 30 is A chord shape (frets 2, 2, 0, 5). Measure 31 is Am chord shape (frets 2, 1, 0, 5). Measure 32 is E chord shape (frets 1, 0, 0, 4). Measure 33 is Em chord shape (frets 0, 0, 0, 3). Measure 34 is D chord shape (frets 2, 3, 2, 5). Measure 35 is Dm chord shape (frets 2, 3, 1, 5).

## Guitar Tricks 76: 3-String Sweeps

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The first system of the guitar trick consists of measures 40 through 42. Measure 40 is marked with a red '40' and the chord 'Asus4'. It contains a 3-string sweep on the top three strings (E, A, D) moving from high to low, followed by a 3-string sweep on the bottom three strings (D, G, B) moving from low to high. Measure 41 is marked with a red '41' and the chord 'A'. It continues the 3-string sweep pattern on the top three strings. Measure 42 is marked with a red '42' and the chord 'A'. It continues the 3-string sweep pattern on the top three strings. The second system of the guitar trick consists of measures 41 through 42. Measure 41 is marked with a red '41' and the chord 'A'. It contains a 3-string sweep on the bottom three strings (D, G, B) moving from low to high, followed by a 3-string sweep on the top three strings (E, A, D) moving from high to low. Measure 42 is marked with a red '42' and the chord 'A'. It contains a 3-string sweep on the bottom three strings (D, G, B) moving from low to high, followed by a 3-string sweep on the top three strings (E, A, D) moving from high to low. The final measure of the second system (measure 42) contains a (12) bend on the D string.
